Instructions ...

Zone 1 = drop off zone for the 420s. Preparation and launching zone for the 420s. Drop off and launch zone for the motor boats.

Zone 2. Anchorage zone for motor boats.

The 420s will stay until Sunday 16th in **Zone 1** and they will return to **zone 3** on Sunday 16th - afternoon. The launching trollies will be brought from zone 1 to 3 by the organization team.

Zone 4. Parking for all vehicles (trailers, lorries and cars). No vehicles are to be parked outside of these zones.

The enrolment, signatures, gauge, briefing, display board, snacks and prize-giving will take place at the race headquarter
